

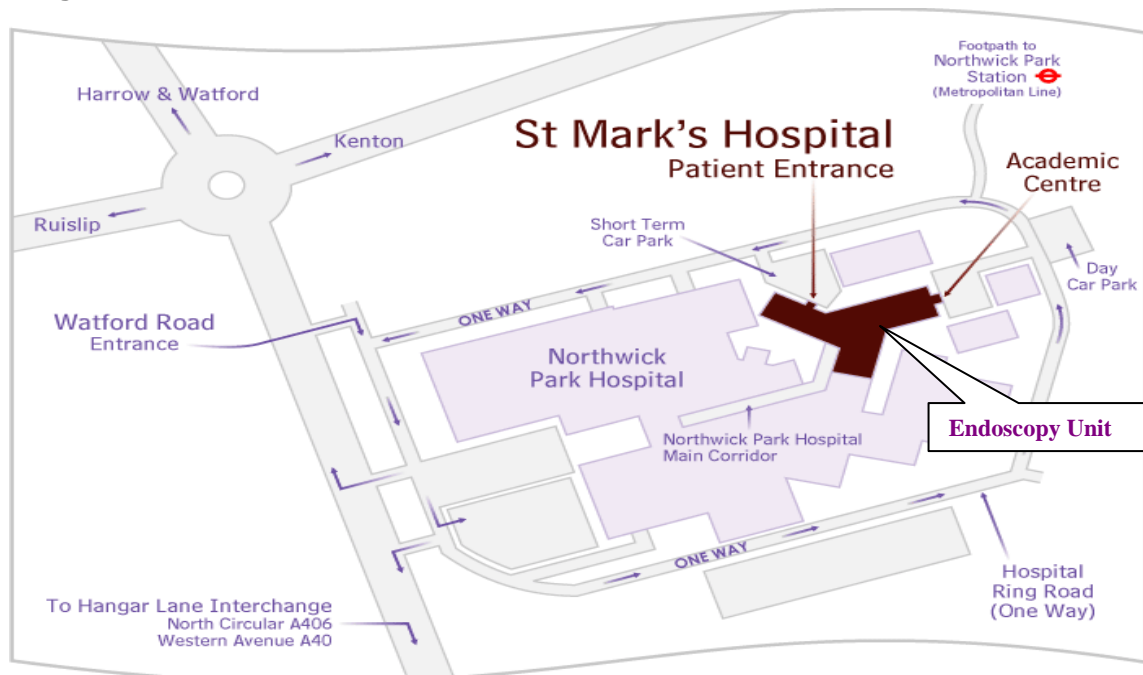
### How to Get to the Endoscopy Unit

Your procedure will take place in the **Endoscopy Unit** which is located on Level 3 (Ground Floor) of St Mark's Hospital. This is best accessed via the St Mark's Hospital Patient Entrance (as indicated in the map below). From the St Mark's entrance, walk straight along the main corridor, through the double doors, and you will find the entrance to the Endoscopy Unit opposite you on the right (just past the lifts).

Once you have arrived, **please report to the main Endoscopy Reception.**

**Should you experience any problems PRIOR TO THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE – (ie if you cannot attend this appointment for any reason), then please contact us on the Freephone number 0800 707 60 60 (9:00am & 5:00pm – Mon to Fri) to arrange an alternative appointment.**

**However, if you experience any problems ON THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE, (ie problems administering the enema or have difficulty in finding us), please contact us on 020 8869 3543 for further guidance.**



Parking is available throughout the hospital grounds but the nearest Car Park is at the St Mark's Hospital Entrance (Car Park 4). Please note that **you should expect to be in the unit for approximately two hours** – the parking charges shown overleaf therefore reflect this.

There are also a limited number of disabled spaces which are free to permit holders.

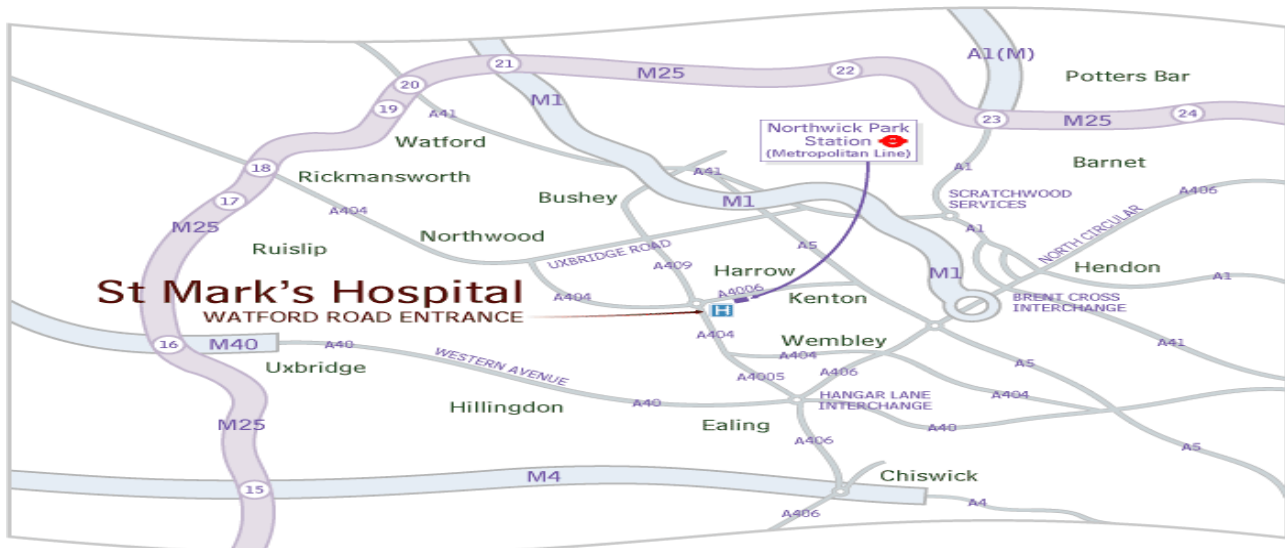
#### **Important Note:**

Patients will therefore be asked to complete a Pre-Attendance form on arrival to ascertain eligibility for free NHS hospital treatment. ## How to Get Here



### By car

Northwick Park and St Mark's Hospitals are situated on one site along the Watford Road in Harrow, near the Northwick Park Roundabout and next to the Play Golf Northwick Park golf club. Please note that the site must be approached from the roundabout to the north; no right-turns from the south are permitted.

A "Pay and Display" Car Park (Car Park 4) is located outside the entrance to St Mark's Hospital. Follow the Northwick Park ring road signs for St. Mark's. **Please note that the parking meters only accept coins and do not give change.** However, a "Pay by Phone" facility is also available for this Car Park. (Further information is located at the parking meters or from the hospital website at the bottom of this page).

Alternative Car Parks are available including the multi-storey Car Park at the front of Northwick Park Hospital (Car Park 1) where parking is payable upon exit.

### Tube and rail links

Northwick Park on the Metropolitan Line is the nearest Tube station to the hospitals, which is approximately five minutes' walk away. Kenton station, for Bakerloo and London Overground services, is about a 10-15 minute walk away.



### Buses

Bus routes 186, 223, H9, H10 and H14 enter the grounds of the hospital, and route 182 stops a short distance away on Watford Road. Bus routes 114 and 183 stop on Kenton Road, about a 10 minute walk from the hospitals.

Low floor, wheelchair accessible buses run on all these routes. Please note the 186 bus now terminates outside St Mark's Hospital, making it more convenient for patients.
